1. **Rationale or background to policy:** CPLF adheres to this Pandemic Protocol to safeguard participants from infection while promoting participant engagement.

2. **Policy Statement:** To provide safety for all participants from contracting the virus.

3. **Procedures:** All participants are to adhere to all Alberta Health Services Recommendations and specifically:

- Participants exhibiting flu like symptoms are not to be allowed in and are encouraged to go home and take the self-assessment online tool.
- All participants are to safe distance at minimum 6 feet apart.
- All participants are to receive their own dedicated art supplies. After session, supplies are disinfected by the participant.
- All participants are to wear a mask for the duration of the session. If one is 6 feet apart from another and drink is required they can temporarily remove mask safety and promptly put mask back on. The rationale for mask wearing indoors is that air is being circulated via the HVAC system.
- Upon leaving workstations they are to be sanitized including chairs and table tops.
- Upon entry, all participants are to sanitize or wash hands.
- No eating during the art class.
- Support Staff are to conduct Enhanced cleaning and General Cleaning in the facility.
