1. Rationale or background to policy:

CPLF's dress code supports appropriate clothes while supporting people with disabilities and in the office.

2. Policy Statement:

CPLF will appreciate a diverse workforce and clothing preferences with a focus on safety and cleanliness.

3. Procedures: Guidance in support of day-to-day decisions

Support Workers

1. Employees must dress in accordance to the individual they are providing support for as reflected in the Worksite Hazard Assessments. In the Hazard Assessments potential Controls can outline appropriate clothing for safety reasons.
2. Runners/flat top shoes are accessible during your shift to provide flexibility and safety depending on the task at hand.

Administration staff

1. Clothing and footwear needs to be in good repair.
