Calgary Transit Holiday Season Access

To all program leaders:

- Regular trip suspensions are effective Monday, Dec 26, 2022 Sunday, Jan 8, 2023.
- Regular bookings will automatically resume on Jan 9, 2023.
- Programs operating between Dec 26, 2022 Jan 8, 2023, customers must book trips up to 4 days in advance, using 1 of 2 methods (this includes booking trips for early dismissal from a program or school, if applicable):
 - 1. Book and cancel trips using our CTA Trip Booking Online (calgarytransit.com) at any time.
 - 2. Call the booking line at 403-537-7777, choosing option number two, Monday to Sunday (closed on statutory holidays) from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)
- If a program closure falls outside of our regular trip suspension period (in part or whole), please advise the customer, their families and/or support networks to cancel any trips they will not be using.
- The CTA Booking Line is open seven days a week from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., closed on statutory holidays. Please advise your customers to plan their calls accordingly.
- Our Booking Line is open seven days a week (excluding public holidays) from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- CT Access does not accept faxes or emails for booking requests.
